



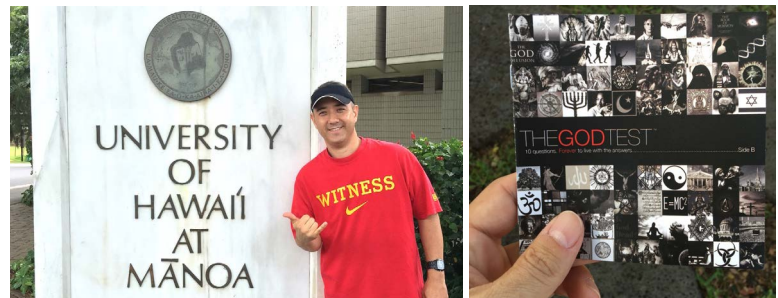

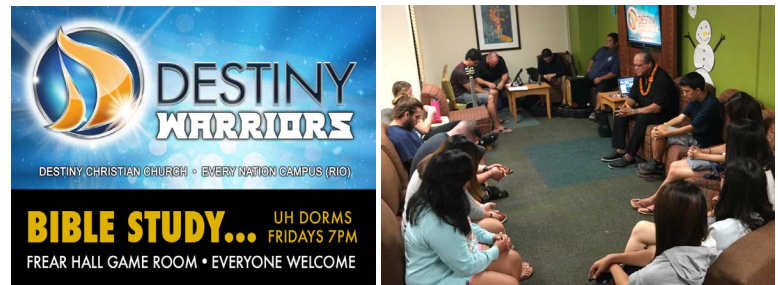
### Pounding the Pavement
